



GRANTS for your **FAYETTE COUNTY** restaurant, hotel, bar, pub, campground ... and possibly others ... are now available for those businesses!

If your hospitality business has been impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic, you may be eligible to receive grant funding Fayette County through Pennsylvania's COVID-19 Hospitality Industry Recovery Program (CHIRP).

Basic eligibility criteria (not all inclusive):

- Located in Pennsylvania (Fayette County businesses will apply through Fay-Penn. Other counties have their own programs.)
- For-profit (Non-profits may be eligible for the federal PPP and EIDL programs. Call Fay-Penn to learn more.)
- Provide accommodations, food, or drink to the public. (NAICS codes beginning with 721 or 722. Some 312 NAICS codes may also be eligible.)
- Fewer than 300 employees and less than \$15 million in business net worth per establishment.

Fay-Penn is accepting applications on behalf of Fayette County on a phased, rolling basis until available funding is exhausted. The Phase I application period is open now through 5:00 PM Eastern, April 15, 2021. Grant amounts awarded will depend on the number of applicants and their reported need. The minimum grant award is \$5,000. If funding remains after Phase I, Phase II will be announced, etc. Note, however, that Fayette County has approximately 500 eligible businesses. It is anticipated that funding will go quickly.
